The Basic Free Medical Clinic (BFMC) began its operations on January 28, 2007 at the Nepal Educational & Culture Center (NECC), Pashupati-Buddha Mandir in Lanham, M.D. It was organized by America – Nepal Women's Association of Greater Washington, D.C. (ANWA) with the help of volunteers to provide Free basic medical services to the uninsured Nepalese community residing in the Washington Metropolitan area and beyond.

The Medical Team consists of all volunteers from the Nepali community coming from all walks of life. Services rendered includes medical care, administrative responsibilities, social work, case management, and other appropriate supports.
